

Charter for the protection of our suppliers' personal data

Faurecia commits to ensure the protection of your personal data regarding to the applicable regulation, notably the French law n°78-17 of January, 6th 1978 as modified (called « Informatique et Libertés ») and the European regulation n°2016/679 of April, 27th 2016 related to the protection of personal data (« GDPR »).

In the context of managing the commercial relationships with its suppliers, Faurecia collects nominative and non-nominative personal data pertaining to the staff and representatives of its suppliers. These personal data are processed by Faurecia for contractual and commercial relationship management purposes, including order management, delivery management, invoicing and accounting management. The provision of such personal data is necessary for the execution of the commercial relationship between Faurecia and the supplier.

The personal data we collect are only destined to Faurecia's exclusive use. However, it can be communicated to other companies of the Faurecia's group and to Faurecia's contractors, whom are obliged to respect the confidentiality of this type of information and to use it only for the very precise operation for which they must intervene.

The personal data can be transferred outside of the European Union. Such transfers are governed by organizational and technical measures to ensure an adequate level of protection of such data (notably through the signature of the contractual clauses). They are stored during the whole commercial relationship period and all the applicable limitation period.

In application of the GDPR and the French law "Loi Informatique et Libertés", you have a right of access, rectification and deletion of personal data concerning your personal data. You also have the possibility to oppose the processing of your data, to request its limitation or portability and to define directives concerning the fate of your data (storage, deletion, communication) in the event of death.

If you feel, after contacting us, that your rights on your data are not respected, you can file a complaint with a supervisory authority, such as the CNIL in France.
